

## S<sup>D</sup> NVT Summer Program 2024 Information

Students will attend for a full day 8:30am-3:30pm or half day 8:30am-11:30am or 12:30pm-3:30pm. This is a minimal 30 day commitment and we do offer make up days. We are unable to offer the program in smaller pieces. Although in some situations student needs may vary and we can creatively try to create 1 spot for 2 students. This will require approval and support from the director. Our goal here is help serve as many students as possible with limited resources.

- \* **General structure** will allow for students to work on IEP goals or attend school based programs for the first half of the day (or for the duration of the school based program) and then transition to an S<sup>D</sup> led afternoon with a focus on social and emotional learning. The S<sup>D</sup> led afternoons will be more of a “camp” setting with peers engaging in physical, social, and interactive activities while working on therapeutic learning goals. The afternoon programming will be based at our locations in Williston and South Burlington. **Behavior Analyst** will be responsible for day to day treatment program data, analysis, staff supervision and will write a progress report at the end of the program., **Special Educator Consult** available to all student programs and the development of the social and emotional camp. If offsite and students are not on site with teachers , all IEP goals typically addressed by school related service providers should be outlined and materials provided to our related services providers to help with continuity **Transportation** can be provided within the program day if needed.
- **Specific logistics** - Please meet with your Behavior Analyst to work out logistics in schedules, program, services etc. We will try to be as flexible as possible with the understanding that resources are tight, we are trying our best to meet a lot of student and staff needs, and sometimes a boundary here or there allows for more people’s needs to be met. Thank you in advance for understanding. \* If schools are not physically available for students to work on their IEP goals in the am we can provide a group setting space at our South Burlington Location. We ask schools to provide Lunch for full day students and we can be creative on how to get them from school cafeterias, if this is not possible we are willing for an additional cost to provide lunch for the students.
